Booking Your Fundraiser

Jimmy Mac's pub offers great fundraising opportunities for your sports team or charitable organization. Please book well in advance.

Availability

- Jimmy Mac's Pub holds fundraisers Saturday through Thursdays. We will not book a fundraiser on a date that may conflict with Monday Night Football or Canucks games.
- The Pub can accommodate up to 100 guests.
- We suggest guests arrive an hour before dinner is served. This gives them time to look at silent auction items and mingle before sitting down for food.

Burger and Beer (\$10.00/person)

The price of the burger and beer ticket will be \$10 including tax. This will include a burger, fries and a sleeve of draft (Canadian, Coors Light, Bud or Jimmy Lager) a bar highball, juice, pop, coffee or tea. All burgers (either beef or veggie) will come with mayo, lettuce, tomato and onion on the bun.

Guest wanting different food items are more than welcome to order from the regular menu.

Tickets

Tickets must be approved by Management before sales start.

We suggest you sell tickets for \$20. This enables a group of 100 to make \$1000 for their organization.

Most groups make their tickets on regular paper. If you're trying to raise money, there's no point spending a lot on getting tickets printed.

A \$150 deposit is needed within two weeks of booking your event. This deposit will be used towards your bill on your event night. If you cancel less than two weeks prior to the date of your event, the deposit is non-refundable.

THREE PARTS OF A TICKET:

Right side: “good for one sleeve of draft, highball, coffee, tea, pop or juice.”

Center: event name, date, arrival time, eating time, Jimmy Mac’s Pub 19935 96 Ave, Langley, (some people number the center part of the ticket for door prizes—this will be the only portion that the customer gets to keep because the server will collect the left and the right portions to order the food/drink)

Left side: “good for one fundraiser burger and fries”

Money Raising Ideas

Silent Auction

Jimmy Mac’s can provide tables for your silent auction items. We suggest you obtain prizes through local community businesses, organizations etc.

50/50 Draw

Some groups hold 50/50 draws to raise extra money – a gaming license is required to have one of these draws. Please see below for instructions on how to obtain one of these licenses.

GAMING LICENCE PROCEDURES FOR FUNDRAISERS FOR 50/50 DRAWS

-Go on the web www.pssg.gov.bc.ca/gaming

-On the left side, click on licenses (gaming event)

-On the left side, click on **Class B** License:

Non-profit organizations raising funds to support programs or services they provide that directly benefit the broader community. (Under 20,000)

OR

-On The left side, click on **Class D** License:

Group, team, or organization must include at least three members who take responsibility for the gaming event. Funds raised must be used to benefit a community and/or third party within British Columbia, or an eligible general purpose of your group or organization that provides direct benefit to a third party or the broader community. (Under 5,000)

Class B License: Click on “Apply – Class B License”

-Scroll down to step #3 – Online Application, or Mail in Application

-On the left hand side click “Apply Online” where you will then need to search your organization.

Class D License: Click on “Apply – Class D License”

-Scroll down to step #3 – Click “Online Services”

-On the left hand side click “Apply Online” where you will then need to search your organization.

Miscellaneous

-it is \$25 non-refundable for class B, \$10 for class D

-it takes three business days to process online applications and up to a week or longer for applications sent through the mail
